

Optical Brilliance Analysis:

Brilliance is the overall return of light to the viewer. The brilliance image is a representation of (a) white areas of light return, or brilliance, and (b) dark-blue areas of light loss.

The colored areas of the symmetry image are indications of light handling ability, giving a visual representation of proportions and facet alignment.
